Distinguished Service Award Guidelines and Qualifications

The Distinguished Service Award is a lifetime achievement award which recognizes a Primary REALTOR member of WCAOR for the effort and work expended on behalf of this Association, fellow REALTORS, and the real estate industry. This award is made only when the Awards Committee determines there is an outstanding, qualified individual. The following guidelines apply. REALTOR nominees must have:

1. Been a Primary member of WCAOR for five or more consecutive years and a REALTOR for a minimum of ten (10) years. Prior recipients are not eligible.
2. Served at least three (3) years as a Director of this Association.
3. Actively served on at least five (5) WCAOR committees, special project groups, or task groups.
4. Served as chairman of at least three (3) WCAOR committees, special project groups, or task groups.
5. Earned at least two (2) professional REALTOR designations such as ABR, GRI, CRS, CRB, etc. as sanctioned by the National Association of REALTORS. (Verify on nominee's profile on www.TexasRealtors.com.)
6. Attended and is actively involved in regional, state, or national REALTOR organizations.
7. Exhibited leadership in community and/or civic activities.
8. Made TREPAC investments of at least 'TREPAC award level' for a minimum of five years.
9. Exhibited evidence of cooperative spirit toward fellow REALTORS as well as professional conduct.
10. Continued to maintain professional competence by attending and/or teaching worthwhile professional-level educational courses.
